

DEED JOHN B. HARLAN

TO JOHN D. MOON, JR

127 Acres March 15, 1856 On Hardware River \$1000.00 ALBEMARLE COUNTY

This deed made this fifteenth day of March in the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Six between John B. Harlan of the one part and John D. Moon, Jr. of the other. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars by the said John D. Moon, Jr. to the said John B. Harlan in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John B. Harlan doth grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said John D. Moon, Jr. a certain tract or parcel of land situated partly in Albemarle County and partly in Fluvanna County on both sides of Hardware River, adjoining Leland Morris, Thomas Moon and others and containing One Hundred and Twenty Seven (127) acres be the same more or less. It being the same tract of land bought by the said John B. Harlan of William B. Isaacs under a deed of trust executed to him by Richard Morris. As see for a more particular description of said land the said deed of trust now on record in the Clerks Office of the Court of Albemarle County, see also the deed of said land to the said John B. Harlan by the said William B. Isaacs as trustee, which last named deed bears date the 6th day September in the year 1851 and is recorded in the same Clerks Office and the said John B. Harlan doth warrant generally the property hereby conveyed. Witness the following signature and seal.
