

DEED WILLIAM GOOLSY TO JOSEPH HARLAN

This Indenture made this 22nd day of March 1825 between WILLIAM GOOLSBY OF THE COUNTY OF BURKE AND STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA by his Attorney, THOMAS BLAIR of the one part and JOSEPH HARLAN of the County of Albemarle and the State of Virginia of the other part. Witness that the said GOOLSBY by his Attorney as aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Thirty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said HARLAN at or before the sealing and delivery of these present, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by those present to bargain and sell unto the said HARLAN, his Heirs and assigns a certain tract, lot or parcel of land lying and being in the said County of Albemarle and adjoining the lands of ISABELLA SQUIRES and others containing by late survey TWENTY-TWO ACRES be the same more or less being the same land which fell to the said GOOLSBY in the division of his FATHERS ESTATE and known more particularly as lot NO. 1 together with all and singular the Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise ? To have and to hold the said tract , lot or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him the said HARLAN his Heirs and assigns forever and the said GOOLSBY by his atty. as aforesaid the said land and its appurtenances unto the said HARLAN his Heirs and assigns free from claim of him the said GOOLSBY his Heirs and all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by the present. In Witness whereof the said THOMAS BLAIR as Atty. for WILLIAM GOOLSBY has hereto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written.
