

DEED - SHOEMAKER TO JOSEPH HARLAN

DEED BOOK: 13 PAGE 354 June 7, 1800 150 Acres 115 Pounds

HEADWATERS OF GREEN CREEK

This indenture made this 7th day of June in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred. Between WILLIAM SHOEMAKER and ELIZABETH his wife of the County of Albemarle on the one part and JOSEPH HARLAN of the aforesaid County on the other part. Witnesseth that the above named WILLIAM SHOEMAKER hath, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifteen Pounds lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, and sell on in Tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Albemarle on the Headwaters of GREEN CREEK containing by estimation One Hundred and Fifty Acres more or less and bounded as follows: To Wit, Beginning at a Corner Chestnut on MASKE LEAKES and WILLIAM BAILEY'S line thence with the said LEAKES line to a corner rock, thence with said line to a corner chestnut, oak thence leaving said line to a corner gum, thence a straight line to a branch and upon said branch as it meanders to a large rock in RITTENHOUSE line formerly JOHN BURKS, thence leaving the branch a little to the left hand to a corner hickory on JOHN ? line thence with said JOHN ? to a corner spanish oak saplin on MASKE LEAKES line thence with said line to a corner chestnut oak on LEAKES AND BAILEY'S line and measures to the beginning with its appurtenances to have and hold the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances to him the said JOSEPH HARLAN and his Heirs forever and the said WILLIAM SHOEMAKER for himself, his Heirs warrent and forever defend, the same land and premises to the said JOSEPH HARLAND and his Heirs forever.
