

WHERE JAMES W. HARLAN LIVED IN 1859

DEED JAMES W. HARLAN TO JOHN S. MOON

THIS DEED made this 15th day of April in the year 1859 between JAMES W. HARLAN of the first part and JOHN S. MOON of the second part Witnesseth that the said JAMES W. HARLAN in consideration of the sum of FIVE DOLLARS to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said JOHN S. MOON the following property viz:

A certain tract of land situated in Albemarle County near JOHN H. COLEMAN'S MILL AND ADJOINING THE LAND OF SAID COLEMAN, JAMES HAMNER AND OTHERS.

This tract or parcel of land contains TWO HUNDRED AND TWENTY FOUR OR FIVE ACRES be the same more or less and is the tract or parcel of land on which the said JAMES W. HARLAN at present resides. Also the following slaves viz:

WILLIS, HARRY, NELSON, JACOB, SOLOMON, MARTHA MOZELLA AND ELIZA a women about forty six or seven years old, and her daughter named Eliza about eighteen years old, also a girl named FANNY and a girl named HELEN the said negroes are at present in possession of the said JAMES W. HARLAN. Intrust to secure the payment of a debt due JOHN D. MOON, JR. by bond Executed to him by the said JAMES W. HARLAN AND JOHN B. HARLAN for TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS bearing date the 15th day of April 1859 and payable on demand with interest from its date and the said JAMES W. HARLAN covenants with the said JOHN S. MOON the he will warrent generally the property herein conveyed.
