## Generation 1

1. **Sarah Harlan** is the daughter of Joseph Harlan and Edith Pyle. She was born on 25 Jul 1748 in Kennett, Twp., Chester Co., PA. Reference ID was 155. She died in Albemarle Co., VA.

**Jesse Harlan** is the son of John Harlan and Sarah Wickersham. He was born 1743 in Bradford Twp., Chester Co., PA. Reference ID was 154. Occupation was miller. Religion was Friend. He died in Albemarle Co., VA.

Notes for Jesse Harlan:

General Notes:

Jesse and Sarah immigrated from Pennsylvania to Maryland after the birth of their children and then they moved on to Albemarle Co., Virginia.

The house where Jesse was born was built about 1725 by his grandfather George. It was enlarged at least once, perhaps when John inherited it when he became 21 (1737) (or more likely, perhaps, when he married in 1740.). It was inhabited by the Harlan family until 1950 when Annie Harlan died. The house title descended through the family of Joel Harlan, the brother of John. [Source: Email message from Elgene A. Jesse Harlan and Sarah Harlan. They were married on 10 Sep 1764 in The Holy Trinity Episcopal Church, Wilmington, DE. Reference ID was 900. They had 7 children.

Married at the Holy Trinity Church (Episcopal) in Wilmington, DE.

General Notes:

Joseph was a planter, miller and millwright. He is buried along side his wife at old homestead, Morris place, in Abemarle Co., Virginia. Joseph and Tabitha were living with their grandson, Thomas Samuel Harlan, in Albemarle Co., Virginia when the 1850 US Census was taken.

- ii. **Samuel Harlan**. He was born on 17 Mar 1766 in Chester Co., PA. He married Jane Goolsby. They were married on 23 Dec 1793 in Albemarle Co., VA. He died 1851 in near present Indianapolis, IN. Reference ID was 158. Occupation was shoemaker. Religion was Methodist.

Notes for Samuel Harlan:

General Notes:

Samuel moved from Pennsylvania to Albemarle Co., Virginia about 1795. After the death of his first wife, he left his son with his wife's people and moved to Tennessee and then on to Madison Co., Alabama where he married his second wife. After the births of all children, they moved to Indiana and settled near the present city of Indianapolis.

Reference ID was 161. Occupation was Tanner, Farmer. Religion was Baptist. Burial in Near Lebanon, Wilson Co., TN.

General Notes:

Thomas moved from Chester Co, PA about 1800 and settled in Albemarle Co, VA, where he married Sarah Eubanks. In 1808 Thomas and Sarah and their three children moved to Davidson Co, TN, near the present city of Nashville, and then in 1820 settled in Wilson Co., TN where Thomas and Sarah died and were buried near the town of Lebanon.

- v. **Jesse Harlan.** He was born on 08 May 1781 in Chester Co., PA. He married Abigail Morris. They were married 1808 in Albemarle Co., VA. He died on 21 Jan 1847 in Albemarle Co., VA. Reference ID was 2700. Occupation was miller. Burial in Morris Buring Grounds, Albemarle Co., VA.
- vi. **Nancy Harlan.** She was born on 06 Jan 1785 in Near Nashville, TN. Reference ID was 2523.
- vii. **Orpha Harlan.** She was born on 25 Aug 1790. Reference ID was 3231.

3. **Edith Pyle** is the daughter of Samuel Pyle and Sarah Pringle. She was born on 03 Feb 1726 in Kennett, Twp., Chester Co., PA. She died on 01 Dec 1771 in Kennett, Twp., Chester Co., PA. Reference ID was 157. Burial in Friends' Burying Grounds, at "Old Kennett Meeting House, Chester Co., PA.

They were married 1700 in Chichester Monthly Meeting House (Friends), Delaware Co., PA. He died on 15 Apr 1731 in England. Reference ID was 1474. Burial in Bunn Hill Burying Grounds.
- ii. **Hannah Harlan.** She was born on 04 Feb 1681 in Donnahlong, Co. Down, Ireland. She married Samuel Hollingsworth. They were married on 08 Jun 1701 in New Castle Co., DE. She died Aft. 1748 in Chester Co., PA. Reference ID was 1477.
- iii. **Moses Harland.** He was born on 20 Dec 1683 in Ulster, Ireland. He married Margaret Ray. They were married 1712. He died on 10 Oct 1747. Reference ID was 1479.
- iv. **Aaron Harlan.** He was born on 24 Oct 1685 in Ulster, Ireland. He married Sarah Heald. They were married 1713. He died Sep 1732. Reference ID was 1481. Burial in Old Kennet Meeting House, Chester Co., PA.
- v. **Rebecca Harlan.** She was born on 17 Aug 1688 in New Castle Co. Del.. She married William Webb. They were married on 22 Jan 1709. She died on 17 Aug 1775 in Chestr Co. Pa. Reference ID was 1483.
- vi. **Deborah Harlan.** She was born on 28 Aug 1690 in William, PA. Reference ID was 1485.
- vii. **James Harlan.** He was born on 19 Aug 1692 in New Castle Co., DE. He married Elizabeth Heald. They were married 1715 in Kennett, Twp., Chester Co., PA. Reference ID was 1487. He died in Frederick Co., MD.

James moved from Chester Co., Pennsylvania, impelled by land hunger. He settled near what is now Martinsburg, West Virginia (but then part of the Virginia Colony), the the lower Shenandoah Valley, and the Harlans became a Berkeley County family for several generations. As far as it it known they took no part in the Revolutionary War. Sometime during this period they ceased to be Quakers. Possibly as a result of the Great Awakening in the 1740s, some wandering revivalist converted them to Presbyterianism. (John Marshall Harlan, by LP Beth).

- viii. **Elizabeth Harlan.** She was born on 09 Aug 1694 in Pennsylvania. She married Joseph Robinson. They were married on 12 Sep 1712. Reference ID was 1489.
- + 4. ix. **Joshua Harlan.** He was born on 15 Nov 1696 in Pennsylvania. He married Mary Heald. They were married Jan 1719. He died May 1744. Reference ID was 1491.
