In the name of God, Amen. I, RICHARD PERKINS of Fluvanna County being of perfect health and memory. Thanks be to Almighty God for the same.

I do make constitute and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following:

First -I give my Soul to Almighty God that gave it, in hopes of pardon for my sins.

And 2ly - I leave my dear wife all my Estate as long as her natural life or widowhood.

And 3ly - I give to my son RICHARD PERKINS five pounds.

AND 4ly - I give to my daughter NANNEY MORRIS twenty five pounds.

And 5ly - To my daughter JANE STONE five pounds.

And 6ly - I give to my daughter Susanna One horse, Bridle and saddle.

And 7 - To my son DANIEL a horse, bridle and saddle.

And 8ly - To my daughter ELIZABETH a horse, bridle and saddle.

And 9ly - My desire is that if my Dear wife should marry, that everything should be sold and equally divided among my children that is now single which is as follows:

PHILLEMONT, SAMUEL, JOHN, SUSANNA, DANIEL AND ELIZABETH

And if my dear wife does not marry my desire is that all my Estate be sold and equally divided among my children that is now single after her death only paying RICHARD PERKINS five pounds.

NANNEY MORRIS twenty five pounds and JANE STONE five pounds and my desire is that all my just debts be paid. What I have given, I give to my children and their Heirs forever, and I do here appoint RICHARD PERKINS and JOHN PERKINS my sons as Executors to this my last Will and Testament. Revoking all Wills by me made heretofore. As witness my hand and seal this twenth day of JULY One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Four.
