Notes for Sarah Harlan:

Jesse Harlan, a son of John and grandson of George, married his third cousin, Sarah Harlan, a daughter of Joseph and a granddaughter of Joshua. Jesse was born about 1743, in Bradford Township, Chester, Pennsylvania. Sarah was born July 25, 1748 in Kennet Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania.

After the birth of their children they moved to Maryland and then onward to Albemarle County, Virginia, where they both died and were buried. Jesse and Sarah were married September 10, 1764 in an Episcopal ceremony at Holy Trinity (Old Swedes) Church, Wilmington, Delaware. It is by this marriage that later descendants are descendent from both George and Michael Harlan. Jesse and Sarah had five children, including including Joseph and Jesse, who are both in the direct line of ancestors as a result of the marriage of first cousins once removed - Thomas Samuel Harlan, son of James White Harlan, grandson of Joseph Harlan, and great grandson of Jesse and Sarah, and Mary Fleming Harlan, daughter of Jesse and granddaughter of Jesse and Sarah Harlan.

Notes for Jesse Harlan:

Jesse and Sarah imigrated from Pennsylvania to Maryland after the birth of their children and then they moved on to Albemarle Co., Virginia.

The house where Jesse was born was built about 1725 by his grandfather George. It was enlarged at least once, perhaps when John inherited it when he became 21 (1737) (or more likely, perhaps, when he married in 1740.). It was inhabited by the Harlan family until 1950 when Annie Harlan died. The house title descended through the family of Joel Harlan, the brother of John. [Source: Email message from Elgene A. Joseph Harlan, son of Joshua and grandson of George, was born May 17, 1723, in Kennet Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania and died there December 22, 1803. His first wife was Edith Pyle, the daughter of Samuel Pyle, a physician, born February 3, 1726 in Kennet Township and died there December 1, 1771. His second wife was Sarah Harlan, the daughter of his first cousin George Harlan (son of Aaron and grandson of George, above) and Elizabeth Hope. Joseph and Sarah had one daughter. Notes for George Harlan:

George Harlan, the eldest of two sons of James Harlan to settle at William Penn's Province of Pennsylvania, b. at Bishoprick, County Durham in far northeast England. He was baptized the 11th day of the 1st mo. 1650 [Mar. 11, 1650/1 in the modern calendar (Kennett, Chester County, Penn. Friends MM Record)] at the Monastery of Monkwearmouth within the City of Sunderland, county Durham. After reaching majority age George relocated to Northern Ireland where he became a member of the Society of Friends, or Quakers.

On the 27th day of the 9th mo. (Nov.), 1678 at the Lurgan Monthly Meeting (hereafter "MM") of Friends at the Parish of Shankill, County Ardmagh, Ulster Province, Northern Ireland, George Harlan m. Elizabeth Duck, daughter of Ezekiel Duck and Hannah Hoop, b. May 5, 1660 at Lurgan. By 1687, George Harlan and wife Elizabeth relocated from Northern Ireland to near Centreville in what was then one of the three lower counties of Penn's Pennsylvania, now in New

Castle County, Delaware. At or near Centreville south of the modern Delaware-Pennsylvania border is where the rest of the children were born.

In 1695 George Harlan was one of Penn's governors of the "lower counties" in present-day Delaware and after moving north along Brandywine Creek to south of present-day Chadds Fork in present-day Delaware County, PA, in 1712 George was elected a member of the Pennsylvania General Assembly.

It is unknown when wife Elizabeth died, but some would claim it was on Nov. 12, 1712. Unfortunately, no Friends MM record contains the recorded date of Elizabeth and husband George's death. George died testate and a widower calling himself in his will "of Brandywine Creek in the Township of Kennett & County of Chester in the Province of Pennsylvania," which today is in the southern portion of Chadds Ford Township, Delaware County, Penn. He died between Apr. 21, 1714 (the date of his will) and Oct 2, 1714 (the date of probate). Some claim George d. on July 5, 1714, but again no record can be found stating his actual date of death. Alpheus Harlan in his History and Genealogy of the Harlan Family claims only that George died in the "Fifth Month" (July) of 1714. Family records used by Alpheus Harlan state George and Elizabeth were buried at "the new burying grounds on Alphonsus Kirk's land, which was afterwards, and is yet today, the Center Meeting Burying Grounds" in Centreville, New Castle County, Delaware.[*2]

George Harlan and Elizabeth Duck had nine children, the first four born at the Parish of Donnahlong in County Down, Ulster Province, Northern Ireland, and the rest at present-day New Castle County, DE after arrival from Ireland. All

Elizabeth Duck and George Harlan had the following children:

She was born in Great Marle, Buckinghamshire, England. She died in Jan 1744 in Kennett Square, Chester Co., Pennsylvania.

She married Samuel Hollingsworth on 08 Jun 1701 in New Castle Co., Delaware. He was born on 27 Jan 1672 in Northern Ireland. He died in Sep 1748 in Chester Co., Pennsylvania.

Notes for Samuel Hollingsworth:

Samuel was of Birmingham, Chester Co., Pa. He was the son of Valentine and his second wife, Ann Calvert. He was born in Ireland, January 27, 1672 and came to America from Belfast, Ireland, with his father, 1682. He married Hannah Harlan, daughter of George and Eliza Harlan, 1701. He died 1748. His will dated August 30, 1748. Proven October 1, 1748. Executors: His son, Enoch, and son-in-law, Henry Green. He mentions his wife Hannah and 4 children.

- iii. Moses Harlan was born on 20 Dec 1683 in Ulster, Ireland. He died on 10 Oct 1747. He married Margaret Ray in 1712. She was born between 1675-1701. She died between 1737-1789.

- v. Rebecca Harlan was born on 17 Aug 1688 in New Castle Co., Delaware. She died on 17 Aug 1775 in Chester Co., Pennsylvania. She married William Webb on 22 Jan 1709. He was born between 1661-1689 in Gloucestershire, England. He died in 1753.

- vi. Deborah Harlan was born on 28 Aug 1690 in William Co., Pennsylvania. She died on 17 Aug 1775 in Kennett Township, Chester Co., Pennsylvania. She married Joshue Calvert. He was born on 18 Aug 1680 in Armagh, Ulster, Ireland. He died in 1753 in Kennett Township, Chester Co., Pennsylvania.
 - vii. James Harlan was born on 19 Aug 1692 in New Castle Co., Delaware. He died in 1762 in Frederick Co., Virginia. He married Elizabeth Heald in 1715 in Kennett Square, Chester Co., Pennsylvania. She was born in 1694 in New Castle County, Delaware, United States of America. She died in 1760 in Frederick Co., Virginia.

Notes for James Harlan:
James moved from Chester Co., Pennsylvania, impelled by land hunger. He settled near what is now Martinsburg, West Virginia (but then part of the Virginia Colony), the the lower Shenandoah Valley, and the Harlans became a Berkeley County family for several generations. As far as it it known they took no part in the Revolutionary War. Sometime during this period they ceased to be Quakers. Possibly as a result of the Great Awakening in the 1740s, some wandering revivalist converted them to Presbyterianism. (John Marshall Harlan, by LP Beth).

Notes for Thomas Harland:

History and Genealogy Of The Harlan Family compiled by Alpheus Harlan. From "History & Genealogy of the Harlan Family," page 2. "Thomas Harland, Yeoman, Friend, b. "Nigh Durham, in Bishopruck, England," where he remained until early manhood, when with his brothers and others he crossed over into Ireland and located in the Parish of Donnahlong, County Down. It is supposed that he remained there during life, and that he was buried in the burying grounds at Lurgan Meeting House, County Armagh. He m. 2, 7, 1680, by ceremony of Friends at Lurgan Meeting, held then "at the house of Francis Robson," in the Parish of Segoe, County Armagh, Katherine Bullock (Friend), b.---, d. 3 Mo. 1690, County Down, a dau. of George Bullock, of the Parish of Donnahlong. They were parents of one son Ananias, and of four daughters, Rebecca, Patience, Christian, and Katherine." "Thomas Harland m. second, 11, 8 1702, Ailice ffoster, of "Lisnegarvy, at Richard Boyes house, Ballinderry Meeting, County of Armagh." They were the parents of two sons, James and Thomas and one dau., Abigail." "We find the names of George Harland, Alphonsus Kirk, etc., among the signers to Thomas Harland's first marriage certificate, but it seems that this brother did not venture to cast his lot in the new world. So far as we can learn he remained in Ireland; we find his descendants, some fifty years later, crossing into Pennsylvania, and settling in Chester County.

Notes for Michael Harland:

Michael and his brother George were yeoman farmers typically looking for better land. They were, or became Quakers and migrated to northern Ireland, presumably as part of the Anglo-Scottish "colonization" of that troubled area begun by Oliver Cromwell. They moved to the New World after George's marriage and settled in Pennsylvania in Chester Co. about 1687. (John Marshall Harlan, by LP Beth)

Michael, a "yeoman, Friend", was born "Nigh Durham, in Bishopruck, England, about the year 1660," and in early life emigrated with his brothers into Ireland and settled with them in the County of Down. Here he remained until 1687, when he accompanied his brother George to America. "And ye beginning of ye yeare 1690," Michael Harlan m. Dinah Dixon, "ye Daughter of Henry Dixon and settled first Neer ye Senter Meeting House." They afterward removed into London Grove Twp., where Michael died the "Fourth Month" (June), 1729, and was bur. in Friends' Buring Grounds. His wife doubtless buried there also."
